### **To Exhibit a Fireplace, please acknowledge the following:**

- A booth plan with spec sheets and notes regarding the placement of fireplaces must be submitted to [Boothplans@lvcva.com](mailto:Boothplans@lvcva.com) regardless of the size of the booth.
- The fireplace must be enclosed with a glass front or a protective heat/contact barrier must be installed to prevent combustible exposure or attendee contact. The fireplace also needs to meet the requirements/code for permanent installation.
- Keep a 5lb ABC (2A:40BC) extinguisher in the booth. The fire extinguisher must have a current inspection tag. Extinguishers may be obtained from the show or a local company.
- Solid fuels will not be used indoors.

### **Fire Pits and open flame appliances:**

Fire Pits and fireplaces without glass enclosures will need to obtain an Open Flame Permit from Clark County Fire. A booth plan will also need to be submitted through [boothplans@lvcva.com](mailto:boothplans@lvcva.com).
